Mature students (year 10-11) will be the first of many to sit their graded exams in music and will be undertaking their grade 2 and grade 4 exams.



Students will be improving their functional ICT skills to help them improve their independence in this subject. Students will eventually be able to send an email and explore the internet safely, ensuring that they can detect viruses, scams, fraudulent AI schemes and other unsafe areas of the internet.

Mature students will be completing their vocational studies in ICT and Music, developing their musical skills and abilities within music production. We will be creating our own media projects where students can create their own tutorial video that explores a topic of their chosen interest. Students will learn how to create a digital recording and will be able to use an industry standard digital audio workstation. Exploring each area of music is vital for students who are planning to continue to work in this environment with life beyond school.
