



Maths

This term in maths, we will learn about time, movement and measurement through practical activities. They will practise telling the time (o'clock, half past, quarter past/to and five-minute intervals) and use this in real-life situations like reading timetables.

We will also explore turns and develop measuring skills both in the classroom, outdoors and at roots, helping them apply maths to everyday life.

English:

This term in English, we will learn how to write clear instructions inspired by *George's Marvellous Medicine*. They will also explore non-fiction texts, research an animal, and practise writing captions and labels for diagrams, and fun facts.



Science

This term in science, we will be learning about how living things survive and interact with their environments. We shall explore different types of adaptation (structural, behavioural and functional) and how animals and plants are suited to where they live. We will also be learning about food chains and food webs, including trophic levels, to understand how energy moves through ecosystems.

History

This term, we will be learning about the Black Death. We will explore how it spread, including the role of the Silk Road, and what life was like in medieval Britain at the time. Children will also learn about medieval medicine and how people tried to treat illness, as well as the impact the Black Death had on people and communities.

PSHE

In this unit, we will explore how to build positive relationships and understand what makes a good friend, while also helping pupils recognise their own unique qualities.
