Science

This half term, children will be learning about health and the human body. We will explore how lifestyle choices such as diet, exercise, smoking, and alcohol can affect our health and wellbeing. Children will also learn about diseases, how the body fights infection, and how medicines help treat illness. We will finish the topic by discovering how the nervous system and hormones help control the body, including changes linked to growth and reproduction. It's set to be a fascinating and engaging topic!

Maths & English

This term in maths, the children will be developing their skills in geometry, measurement and statistics through practical and engaging activities. They will learn about 2D and 3D shapes, including their properties, symmetry, faces, edges and vertices. The children will also practise measuring length, perimeter, mass and capacity, and will learn how to collect and present data using tally charts, pictograms and bar charts.

In English, the children will be focusing on newspaper reports. They will learn about the features of a newspaper report, including headlines, introductions, facts, quotes and formal language.

Humanities

This term in geography, the children will be learning all about the United Kingdom. They will explore the countries, capital cities, landmarks and physical features of the UK, while developing their map-reading and location skills.

In history, the children will be learning about King Henry VIII and the Tudor period. They will discover what life was like during Tudor times, learn about Henry VIII's six wives, and explore how his decisions changed England's history.
